Descrpition: Join HVCS' Syringe Exchange Program (SEP) in the Mid-Hudson Valley and help linke individuals struggling with injection drug use find the help they need.

As the Harm Reduction Prevention Specailist you will identify and link substance users to syringe exchange and harm reduction services provided by the program. You will work as part of a mobile team to conduct syringe exchange in Ulster and Sullivan Counties. Responsibilities also include driving the team vehicle, providing clients with HIV/HCV and overdose prevention education, providing opioid overdose prevention (Narcan) training to clients and community members, providing referrals to medical and drug treatment and social services, and conducting HIV/HCV counseling and testing.

This full-time position is based in Lake Katrine and reports to the program supervisor for the Mid-Hudson SEP Program.

At Hudson Valley Community Services (HVCS) we provide care management services for individuals with chronic illnesses, including HIV, and education and prevention services in New York's Hudson Valley region.
