Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) Assessment Team

The CISM Assessment Team provides consultation and strategic planning services in collaboration with the District's Emergency Response Team during a disaster or crisis with potential to impact the larger school community. The CISM Assessment team works to ensure the Social Emotional needs of students and staff are addressed in accordance with the CISM framework and [NECSD Crisis Response Protocol](#).

CISM Assessment team members will be expected to respond during, after, or before school hours to meet with district officials and determine if, when, and what type of CISM interventions are appropriate for various target groups potentially impacted by the incident. The CISM Assessment team will collaborate with district officials to conduct a needs assessment using the [CISM Protocol Template](#), and support buildings in need of CISM Intervention and support.
