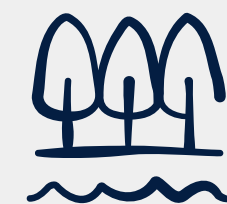

- **Students do not automatically remain at the same school they attended for Pre-K.**
- If you do **not** complete the survey, **your child will be assigned to a school.**

Completing this process ensures that your preferences are considered for your child's Kindergarten placement.

Additionally, there will be a **Kindergarten Information Session on February 25 at 6:00 PM** for families of students entering Kindergarten in September.

! Please note the time carefully:

- The **5:00 PM session is for incoming Pre-K students** and is **not** intended for current Pre-K families.
- Families of Pre-K students should attend the **6:00 PM Kindergarten session.**
