



This is an exciting initiative to recognize students in a positive manner.


We will celebrate students in a ceremony on March 25th.

Let's Clear the Air Anti-Vaping Parent Workshop
March 5th @ NFA North Auditorium
5:30 PM

This workshop is designed to provide parents and caregivers with clear, accurate, and up-to-date information about vaping and its impact on adolescents. In a supportive and non-judgmental setting, we will explore what vaping is, why it has become increasingly popular among teens, and how it affects physical health, mental well-being, and academic performance.

Participants will gain insight into nicotine addiction, the effects of vaping on the developing teenage brain, and common myths and misconceptions often promoted through social media. The workshop will also offer practical strategies for starting open, supportive conversations with teens, recognizing warning signs, and responding effectively if concerns arise.

Our goal is to equip families with knowledge, communication tools, and community resources to help their children make informed, healthy choices now and in the future.
