
PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Dear Heritage Middle School,

March is Womens History Month. Women's History Month began as a local "Women's History Week" celebration in Sonoma County, California, in 1978, organized to coincide with International Women's Day on March 8th. It was created to address the lack of women's contributions in K-12 curriculum. The initiative gained national recognition in 1980, becoming a full month by 1987.

The official colors of Women's History Month are purple, green, and white, representing dignity/justice, hope, and equality, respectively.

- Purple -Symbolizes justice, dignity, loyalty, and is recognized as the international color for gender equality.
- Green: Represents hope, growth, and new beginnings.
- White: Represents purity, freedom, and equality.
