

Transportation of Injured/Temporarily Disabled Students

On occasion a student may have an injury, illness or temporary disabling condition that may prevent the student from being safely transported on general education busses. In some cases this condition (crutches, mobility devices, etc.) may require special transportation arrangements.

In the event your child may require special transportation arrangements due to an injury or temporary disability, please contact the health office at your child's school. The health office will provide the necessary paperwork and physician's documentation required to initiate a temporary special transportation request. The request will then be forwarded to the Health Services Coordinator for review. Approval for special transportation arrangements is subject to both doctor's certification and approval by the District's Health Services Coordinator.

If approved, notification of the transportation requirements and the expected duration of special transportation arrangements will be provided to the Transportation Department by the Health Services Coordinator. Processing of special transportations arrangements usually take 1-2 business days. Parents will be contacted directly by the bus company to confirm schedule information prior to the start of transportation.
