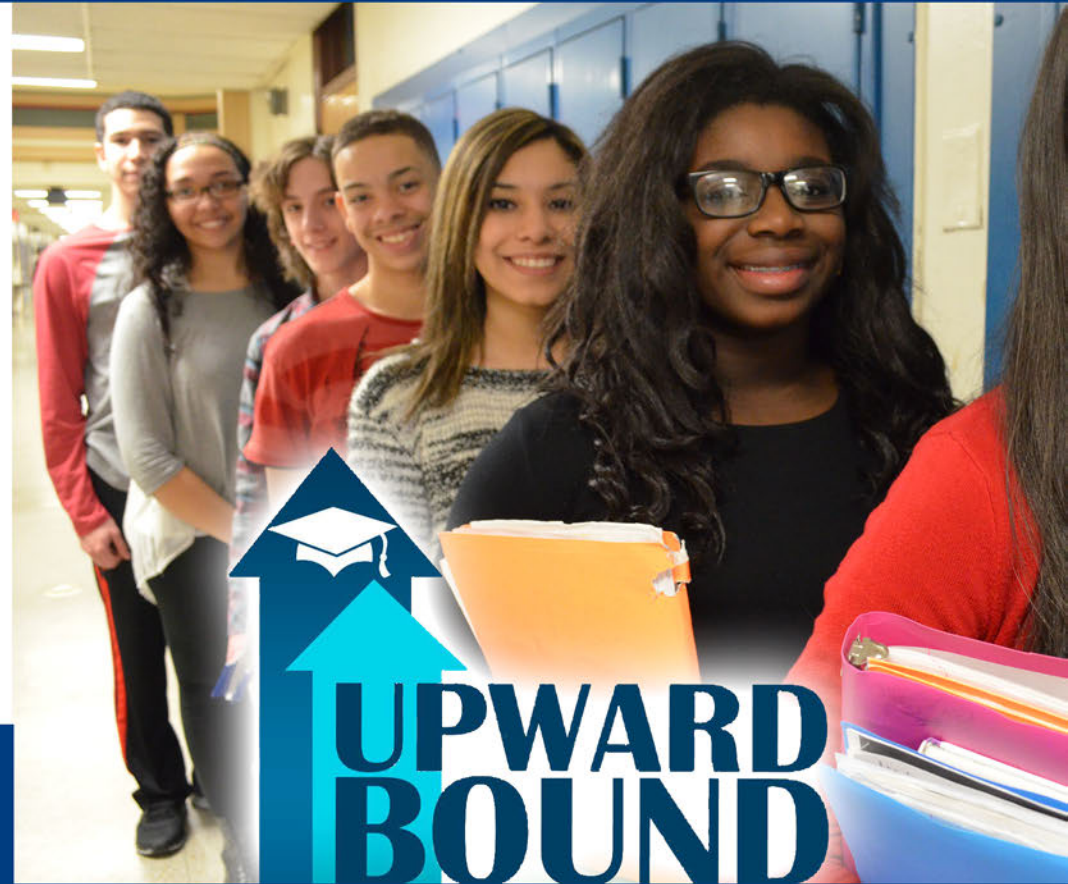

- ✓ Incoming 9th and 10th grade scholars who are on track to complete the grade level but need academic supports.
- ✓ Candidates who are interested in entering a college program after completing high school.
- ✓ Candidates willing to make a commitment to meet high school graduation requirements.
- ✓ Candidates must have academic needs and college potential

## WHAT DOES UPWARD BOUND OFFER OUR SCHOLARS

- ✓ Help students develop a sense of self-reliance and independence.
- ✓ A six-week summer residential experience at Marist College Main Campus, which provides room and board.
- ✓ Skills building in English, math, science, social studies, and foreign language.
- ✓ Career planning
- ✓ Recreational activities
- ✓ Personal and academic advisement and mentoring
- ✓ Transportation home on the weekends

During the summer program, Upward Bound provides workshops that emphasize study skills, academic planning, career exploration, and assistance with college admission and the application processes. The program also offers tutorial services, a variety of cultural and social activities and supports for the families of participants.
