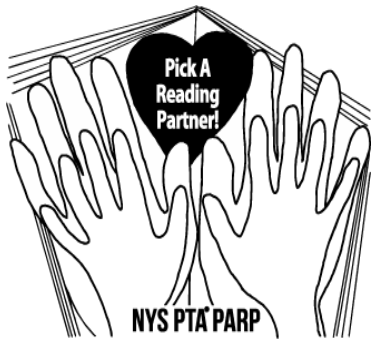

The Hudson River is a 315-mile river that originates in upstate New York, flows through the Hudson Valley, and eventually drains into the Atlantic Ocean. The river is 315 miles long. An area known as "World's End" is the deepest part of the Hudson at 202 feet. The river is named after Henry Hudson, an Englishman, who explored it in 1609. Settlements of the colony clustered around the Hudson, as it was an important gateway to the American interior. Many landmarks have been constructed along the Hudson: Franklin Roosevelt's home, The Walkway of the Hudson, Bannerman's Castle and the United States Military Academy to name a few.
