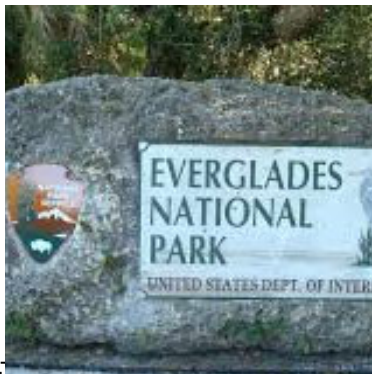

Our 2nd stop on the exploration of our National Parks is in the state of Florida - The Everglades National Park - established in 1947.

This park's 1.5 million acres include forests of cypress, pine and mangrove, islands, swampy vegetation, and lots of water. Hundreds of birds live in the park, along with panthers, manatees, snakes, alligators and crocodiles. The Everglades is a paradise for fishing, boating, hiking, swimming and camping.

The earliest Everglades Native Americans were the Calusas and the Tequestas. In the late 1700s, Native Americans that were being crowded out of Georgia and Alabama settled in Florida and came to be known as the Semionoles.

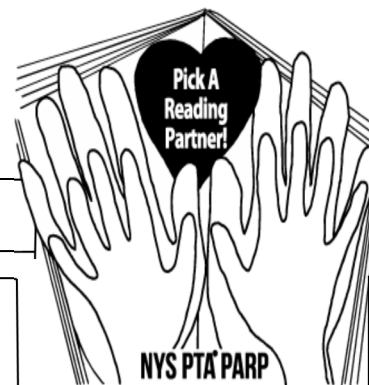
