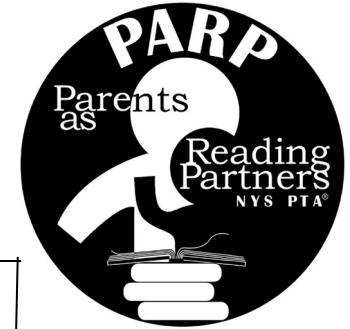

This year we will be exploring the National Parks across the United States. As we read each month you will learn about one of our nations 51 beautiful and fascinating parks. Let's move from the east coast to the west coast.

Our first stop will be the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. This park lies on the border between Tennessee and North Carolina. The name *Smoky* comes from the mist that often floats over the mountaintops and hangs in the valleys.

Great Smoky Mountains National Park has more than 100 kinds of trees and 3,500 varieties of plant life. The park is also home to bears, foxes, deer, bobcats, a variety of birds and fishes. Cherokee Indians once lived on the lands that now make up this park. Many of the mountain peaks in the park are more than 6,000 feet high!
